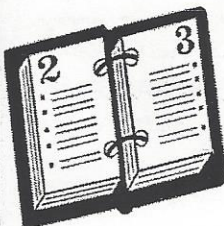
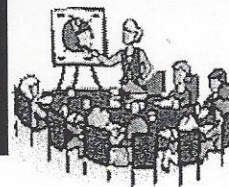

This workshop will examine how to use group grievances as tools to organize membership and build power in the workplace. Participants will discuss how to identify issues that present organizing opportunities and plan strategic campaigns that use escalating tactics to pressure management into improving the workplace. This workshop will also cover the importance of one-on-one conversations, small meetings, and rank-and-file activism in establishing the foundation of a thriving union. This advanced workshop is designed for CSEA grievance representatives who have experience in handling grievances and other violations in the workplace.
